## How is it with your soul?

The Lord speaks strongly against the false shepherds, false pastors, and false prophets. Several passages in Jeremiah are written with harsh words concerning those who speak forth in the Name of the Lord but speak lies and deceit (Jer 20.6; 14.13, 14; 23.21). Awaken! Discern by the Holy Spirit when someone is using the Name of the Lord but does not speak truth, the truth of the Lord Jesus Christ. Beware of those who speak in a way that you will think they are saying what they think you want to hear, but their words have a different meaning, full of deceit. Pastors and shepherds and prophets – **all** servants of the Lord Jesus Christ, hear the Word of the Lord. Read II Timothy 3.1-5!!

### Plumbline: II Timothy 4.2-4

Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

And they shall turn away [their] ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

Perhaps there needs to be some soul searching as King David prayed:

Psa 139:23 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:

Psa 139:24 And see if [there be any] wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.
