Work of the Holy Spirit

Interestingly that after I retired for the evening October 16, 2020, a *Word* came to me in power that reminded me that these days that lie before us are days of preparation for the work to which we are called. I was reminded that we must prepared for the work at hand, the work to which the Lord showed me in the fall of 2009.

Life changed in the United States as well as in all countries. I was reminded how easily we are distracted from the work of the Lord when the enemy, when Satan engages in a battle for the lives of many of those who believe they are okay with the Lord as long as they are "church-goers." However, Satan is not only after them and winning them beyond count, but he is clamoring for those of us who know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and desire with desire to live for HIM Who died for us, Who loves us so much that He gave His life on Calvary, shed His blood for our sins. But praise the Lord; He arose victoriously over sin, hell, and the grave. He calls us to continue walking with Him in these sad and volatile days that lie before us. He calls us to continue serving Him, to continue daily telling everyone one we encounter about His love for them, to lead them to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

I am concerned because so many hiding behind the pulpit, standing on a pulpitum, are failing to preach the Word of God in Christ Jesus by the power of the Holy Spirit, failing to edify the body of Christ and encourage them to serve the Lord Jesus Christ in their daily lives.

We have forgotten the work of the Holy Ghost in our lives. We have failed to seek the work of the Holy Ghost in our lives that we might go forth in the power and anointing of the Holy Ghost to accomplish the work to which we are called for the Lord Jesus Christ.

Let us look at some of the Scriptures and sit with them, asking the Holy Spirit to reveal to us His work to be done in us for the glory of the Lord Jesus Christ. I am reminded of the following, a strong word to the followers of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Eph 5:15 See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,

Eph 5:16 Redeeming the time, **because the days are evil**.

Eph 5:17 Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord [is].

Eph 5:18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but **be filled with the Spirit**;

Eph 5:19 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;
Eph 5:20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;
Eph 5:21 Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

Read the above passage and re-read it and re-read it, seeking what the Lord is saying, no seeking to know the Lord commands and demands of us in this life and all for His glory. How can we lead people to Jesus Christ in these days - if our lives are no different from the world's way of life? How can someone lead another to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior - if they, themselves, know not the Lord God Almighty in Christ Jesus by the Holy Spirit?

The followers of Jesus Christ are commanded to be filled with the Holy Ghost, be sanctified by the Holy Ghost (Rom 15.16).

Rom 15:16 That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.

I am not sure we understand what we read in a day and age when there is so much neanderthalism even in the professional world. People believe that whatever you believe a word means to you that is sufficient for the truth, the definition of the word. After all, life is all about you, you, you!! so Satan teaches through his followers who come to us in sheep's clothing (Mt 7.15; 10.16; Lk 10.3; Acts 20.29).

We live in a very sick world in which Satan rules, but, oh! the day is coming and is coming soon when he and his followers all through the centuries shall go to their reward. But, in the meantime, we must stand strong in the Word of the Lord Jesus Christ and live for Him, following His Word.

Isa 33:2 O LORD, be gracious unto us; we have waited for thee: **be thou their arm every morning, our salvation also in the time of trouble**.

Oh, how we need to be in prayer that we might go forth in Him in these days of trouble for Tribulation is upon us, is knocking at the door.

The word of the Lord Jesus Christ is not going forth in the square buildings because those standing on the pulpitums know not the Lord Jesus Christ. They have not the anointing upon them and the power of God in Christ Jesus by the Holy Spirit is not in them nor in what they are saying. You cannot introduce someone to another if you have not yet met them. Oh, you can say words, but they are empty words when you have not met the Master, the Lord Jesus Christ.

Let us look at the Ephesian passage verse by verse and look at our own lives and ask the Lord Jesus Christ, "What are you saying to me, to those of us who desire to walk in obedience to you, to take up our cross and follow You?"

We need to remind ourselves of the power of the Holy Ghost upon Peter and that great sermon he preached in Acts. We need to remind ourselves at the power of the Holy Ghost upon those hearing the Word that went forth under the power of the

Holy Ghost and how the Holy Ghost touched the lives of the 3,000 that were saved that day under the powerful preaching of the Word by Peter.

Oh, let us seek the Lord in our lives that the anointing of the Holy Ghost would be upon us as we go forth understanding the will of the Lord in each of our lives and for His glory. Let us seek the Lord in our lives that the anointing of the Holy Ghost would be upon us as we, each walking in obedience to the call of the Lord upon our lives, go forth realizing that we are to walk as the body of Christ, walking together, each as a member of the body of Christ, praying one for another that we might go forth as the body, walking in the Truth of the Lord - not as an individual trying to be heard above the Lord's voice in and through each one who is a part of the body of Christ. This can only be if we are walking in Christ Jesus by the power of the Holy Ghost (Eph 4.1; Gal 5.25; Rom 8.1; Acts 3.12).

There are many passages giving to us the Work of the Holy Spirit. Most have never been preached or taught. For many years, the Word of the Lord has gone by the wayside in lieu of motivational speeches. For many years now the Word of the Lord has been made a mockery of by Satan and his angels - as those hiding behind a pulpit while standing on a pulpitum have extrapolated scripture verses, a phrase, a word, to use for the one they follow, that people who care nothing about the Lord Jesus Christ may have their way in this life on earth - but spending eternity in hell with the one they followed, Satan. There is a song that makes clear from where our power comes if we are serving the Lord Jesus Christ,

We've got the power in the Name of Jesus.
We've got the power in the Name of the Lord.
Though Satan rages, we will not be defeated.
We've got the power in the Name of the Lord.
