How is it with your soul?

Edifying the Body of Christ (Eph. 4.10-16)

Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

I am reminded of those whose hearts and lives were joined with the body of Christ in the Book of Acts. There were those whose hearts were lifted up by the reading of the Holy Word of God, by the fellowship (κοινωνία) in the Word of the Lord and the breaking of bread together.

Few have read this passage and even fewer understand, know, what fellowship in the Lord is. I recall a Bible study that Deaconess Lowery and I had in our home, and two people interrupted the study saying they came to fellowship as the Holy Spirit teaches them and then they teach us. They just came for fellowship with the following conversation taking over about hot dogs and buns and . . .

I dismissed that group as some of us came for a time together in the Word, to lay ourselves before the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Bible teaches that we are to edify the body of Christ.

Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another (Rom 14.19).

Edify is to build up the body with Truth, the Truth of the Lord God Almighty. It is to be built up in the Lord. It is promoting growth in Christian wisdom, piety, holiness, obedience unto the Lord God.

Too many believe that edifying the body is to flourish people with words of how good they are, and how wonderful they are doing. The Lord God made it clear to the false prophets who spoke falsely to the people. Know that the Lord does not send the false prophets, shepherds, pastors or any one who is not living in the will of the Lord.

Seek the Lord daily in the Word of the Lord and walk with Him. All that we do must be for the Lord and for His glory.
