Amo 7:7 Thus he shewed me: and, behold, the Lord stood upon a wall [made] by a plumbline, with a plumbline in his hand.

Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Mat 24:23 Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here [is] Christ, or there; believe [it] not.

Mat 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if [it were] possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

Mat 24:33 So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, [even] at the doors.

Too long we have heard that the coming of the Lord will be many, many years hence; perhaps during my great, great, great, great grandchildren's lives. This nation has forgotten the Word of the Lord and is "playing while Rome burns."
