
I ask these questions only to share with you what a holy life full of the glory of the Lord looks.

Moses responded to the call of the Lord and paid the price – and did not even get to enter the Promised Land.

So, how do you live a Christian life? Deuteronomy 6:4-9 says it well.

“Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Recite them to your children and talk about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise. Bind them as a sign on your hand, fix them as an emblem on your forehead, and write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.”
