Hide for Fear of the Lord

I began taking pictures, but I was not the only one who was seeing the *seemingly* significance of the appearance of the sky.

It was interesting how this came to my attention in the midst of working on this series of *Messages*, "Hide for Fear of the Lord."

Yes, Isaiah 2.17 says that the Lord alone shall be exalted in that day. I think of the following hymn, "What A Day That Will Be."

No more clouds in the sky, no more tears to dim the eye;
All is peace for evermore on that happy golden shore.
What a day, glorious day that will be.

What a day that will be when my Jesus I shall see,
And I look upon His face – the one who saved me by His grace;

What a day, glorious day that will be.

I believe there is much yet to come before us from the Word of the Lord. We will see the Lord alone being exalted in that day. We will see the idols utterly abolished and the fear of the Lord, and the glory of His majesty – "when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth."

Notice this is repeated twice in this chapter. We need to listen always to the Word of the Lord and to **hear** (obey) the Word of the Lord. But take notice this is repeated twice in the same chapter (Isa 2.19-21).

And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, **when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.**
In that day a man shall cast his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which they made *[each one]* for himself to worship, to the moles and to the bats;
To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, **when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.**

Oh, let us each one who knows Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, be strengthened in His Word, walking with Him all the way. Let us pray one for another that, in these days that lie before us, we will be able to lead others to Jesus Christ who know not the "Fear of the Lord" as is given us from the Book of Isaiah, those that run to the caves with hearts hardened against the Lord, but will **come to know the Fear of the Lord in His Holiness** and His love for us desiring to walk the life of holiness.

Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,
By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say,
his flesh;
And *[having]* an high priest over the house of God;
Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled
from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.
Let us hold fast the profession of *[our]* faith without wavering; (for he *[is]* faithful that
promised;) (Heb 10.19-23)

**... sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and *[be]* ready always to
[give] an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the
hope that is in you with meekness and fear** (I P 3.15).

Come apart and rest (Mark 6.31).

There shall be great fear, but it will not be the fear that comes from one who knows the Lord Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, nor will it be a fear of one who does not know the Lord Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and is ready to turn to the Lord. I believe when that time comes, there is finality in those who decided against the Lord, and their fear shall be as these series of *Messages* say, "Hide for fear of the Lord." In that day they shall know that the Lord God Almighty is God over all. They shall recognize that as they seek to hide and cry out to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb."

We wrote earlier of the Day of the Lord, when He shall come with judgement upon all, and there will be division of those who have chosen the broad road that leads to destruction and the narrow road that leads to eternity with Jesus Christ forevermore.

And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand? (Rev 6.15-17)

Isaiah 2.21 aligns with Revelation Six. But there is more for us who know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. But first, let me say that time is of the essence, and we need to preach the old time Gospel, the Word of Truth, the Truth of Jesus Christ that our family and friends may come to know Jesus Christ. We need to live that old time Gospel and speak to people and pray for them to come to know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. This is the calling of everyone who know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior – to go forth proclaiming the way of salvation for the Lord says in His Word that today is the day of salvation.

(For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *[is]* the accepted time; behold, now *[is]* the day of salvation.) (2Co 6:2)

And then go forth giving the Word to family and friends.

Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts (Heb 4:7).

Oh, hear the Word of the Lord from the Book of Revelation.

And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death (12.9-11).

Those of you who know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, tell the world of His great love for you and what He has done for you. Then, go forth endeavoring to lead others to Jesus Christ.

There is a *feel* that people are ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ because they are not telling others about what He did for them on the Cross of Calvary. I tell you now

that when I fell in love with my godly husband, I went forth telling all that I knew of His love for me - and my love for Him. I was not ashamed of the gift the Lord Jesus placed in my life, Nor am I ashamed of the One, the Lord Jesus Christ, Who chose to bring us together that we might tell of The Love of God as we walked together in marriage.

How much more should we be telling the world of The Love of God in Christ Jesus Who came to this earth, was crucified, died, buried, and rose victoriously over sin, hell and the grave – Who gave His life that we might have life now and forevermore with Him through all eternity!

Go forth in obedience to the Lord God Almighty, in the Name of Jesus Christ.

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *[even]* unto the end of the world. Amen (Mt 28.18-20).

In all the years that my colleague and I have travelled coast to coast for the Lord Jesus Christ, and have written the *Message* monthly that went into 38 states, never have we felt the need so great as now to have the Word of God put before you as is in this *Message*. Oh, we have written the *Message* based on the Holy Word and have included it always in each *Message*, but this month it seems the Lord put before us more passages to include in this specific *Message*. This issue is to encourage those who know the Lord Jesus Christ to go forth in the power of His might, telling others of His love for them. Be strengthened, and put on the Armor of God as St. Paul gives to us (Eph 6.10-20).

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *[places]*.

Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; Eph 6:19 And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,

For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.
