## How is it with your soul?

**A**rise! We need to arise in the Lord and walk on water, walk by faith and not by sight. We live in a world today of an attitude of "I know everything. I don't need anyone telling me what to do." I have seen and heard some say that if "that thing in the ceiling giving off light is an airplane to someone, it is an airplane." Today whatever you want to believe is right because you said it.

The Word of God makes it clear that His ways and thoughts are higher than ours. We need to submit to the Lord, seeking Him and Him alone, and walk in His ways – trusting Him with our lives **when** we walk in obedience to Him.

There is a hymn that encourages us own to walk in the Lord, "Trust and obey, for there's no other way To be happy in Jesus, But to Trust and obey." Paul wrote in II Corinthians 5.7, "For we walk by faith, not by sight." The writer of the Book of Hebrews gives us, "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" (Heb 11.1).

### Plumbline: Proverbs 3.5, 6

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
