O **give thanks to the Lord of lords:** for his mercy [endureth] for ever (Psa 136:3).

O **give thanks unto the God of heaven:** for his mercy [endureth] for ever (Psa 136:26).

IN EVERY THING GIVE THANKS: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you (1Th 5:18).

Walking in the Light of the Lord Jesus Christ, the only Begotten Son of the Lord God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Israel) is living a life of thanks-giving unto the Lord, obeying His commandments, which is more than the Decalogue, the Ten Commandments.
