How is it with your soul?

As we walk day by day with the Lord, the enemy comes in to kill, steal, to divert us from the way of the Lord. There are many times people will take a detour, only to find it took them to another place. Isaiah says that when we even think of taking a side trip, taking a short cut, going another way, we need to hear the voice of the Lord, "This is the way, walk ye in it," that we might not go another way, that we might not go with the enemy.

This is true for those following, those endeavoring to live for the Lord God; however, this is true for all who might think the way they are going will eventually lead to the place for those who are goodly. This is not true for the Lord Jesus Christ calls His followers to a life of godliness, holiness – not goodliness.

Plumbline: Isaiah 30.20, 21

Isa 30:20 And [though] the Lord give you the bread of adversity, and the water of affliction, yet shall not thy teachers be removed into a corner any more, but thine eyes shall see thy teachers:

Isa 30:21 And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This [is] the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

Perhaps there needs to be some soul searching as King David prayed:

Psa 139:23 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:

Psa 139:24 And see if [there be any] wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.
