Amo 7:7 Thus he shewed me: and, behold, the Lord stood upon a wall
[made] by a plumbline, with a plumbline in his hand.

Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

What is a godly life? Why are those living a godly life persecuted so severely, especially in other countries – which seems not to be just in other countries now. Let us awaken to what is around us. Seek discernment and wisdom from the Lord to walk on in Him as we see so many changes, many which have been very small, but as the small changes come together, we can begin seeing a larger picture of all the changes.

What is a godly life? It is living in obedience to the Lord God Almighty's commands, loving Him, and reverencing Him, Who He is, knowing His ways are beyond our knowing, knowing His ways are right. It is also knowing that the Lord God loves us, and His commands are for our good.

A godly life is a life faithful unto the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel. It is avoiding that which is evil, that which is not of the Lord. A godly life is a life of love unto the Lord Jesus Christ Who loves us so much that He gave His life on the cross of Calvary for our sins, for the ungodly. It is worshipping Him, giving adoration unto Him, honoring His Holy Name.

When reading the Word of God in Christ Jesus, it is writing that "All that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution" (II Tim 3.12). Many do not understand this, thinking that the Lord will deliver His followers out of all persecution; but, not so for the enemy, Satan and his followers, are full of hate and want to draw people away from the Lord by any means – to include persecution.

Let us as the body of Christ encourage one another in our walk with the Lord as we seek to live a godly life, and as we reach out to a world who knows not the Lord Jesus Christ. But know we are not to walk with the world as we reach out to them with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
