Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Read the Word of God with your heart, and take it to heart. Awaken! to what is going on around you and beyond your small world. The Word of God has given to us more information than you will ever read in the national newspapers. I just opened the Bible and it fell open to the following passage which goes with what I finished writing in the *Message* last evening (II Th 2.5-12).

Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things? And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.

For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth [will let], until he be taken out of the way.

And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:

[Even him], whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,

And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:

That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

Saint Paul goes on to encourage us to stand fast to what we know to be the Truth and walk on in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Psa 119:11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.
