Amo 7:7 Thus he shewed me: and, behold, the Lord stood upon a wall
[made] by a plumbline, with a plumbline in his hand.

How is it with your soul?

The Word of the Lord continues reminding us to Take Heed lest:

And Jesus answering them began to say, Take heed lest any [man] deceive you:
For many shall come in my name, saying, I am [Christ]; and shall deceive many (Mk
13.5, 6).

Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that **I will send a famine in the land, not a
famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD:**

And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run
to and fro **to seek the word of the LORD, and shall not find [it].** (Amos 8.11-14).

St. Francis of Assisi once said,

Preach always, and if necessary use words."

Plumbline: II Timothy 4.2, 3

Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all
longsuffering and doctrine.
For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts
shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;
And they shall turn away [their] ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.
But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full
proof of thy ministry (II Ti 4.2-5).

Perhaps there needs to be some soul searching as King David prayed:

Psa 139:23 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my
thoughts:

Psa 139:24 And see if [there be any] wicked way in me, and lead me in
the way everlasting.

Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of
God.

Paul writes to the Church of Corinth,

For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband,
that I may present [you as] a chaste virgin to Christ.

But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your
minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or [if] ye
receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have
not accepted, ye might well bear with [him] (II Cor 11.2-4).

Oh, all through the centuries, people have turned to false Christs, false teachers,
false preachers, and false prophets – and, have an interested in becoming one like
them. How many stand before you, and are not called of the Lord God
Almighty. Oh, yes, even in days of Jeremiah, the Lord spoke to those who were
not called of Him.

And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.

And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold (Mt 24.11, 12).

Hear what Mark wrote:

Mar 13:21 And then if any man shall say to you, Lo, here [is] Christ; or, lo, [he is] there;
believe [him] not:

Mar 13:22 For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall shew signs and
wonders, to seduce, if [it were] possible, even the elect.

Mar 13:23 But take ye heed: behold, I have foretold you all things.

We read "**Take heed . . .**" 55 times in the Bible. I leave you with that
admonition as the Lord Jesus Christ has given us this in His Holy Word.

Psa 119:11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin
against thee.
