When God's Wrath Is Stirred!

Or, should the question be asked, What will it take to awaken this nation to the sins that have been committed against the Lord God Almighty in Christ Jesus, the only Begotten Son of the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Israel)? Oh, I fear that the ears of this nation are deafened to the voice of the Lord. I fear that the ears of those standing on the pulpitum are also deafened – as well as the church-goers – at this point in history.

Oh, I long for the old-time preachers of yester-year who preached under the anointing of the Holy Spirit, and the Word of the Lord God that came through them so strong. They said and could say, **Thus – saith – the Lord**, with power because they had heard from the Lord through the reading of the Holy Bible, and because they spent hours in prayer seeking the Truth for the hearers – as well as for themselves.

All through the Bible, since the beginning of time, we read where the wrath of God was upon His people who walked in disobedience to Him. How they walked in disobedience, and, yet, expected to be blessed by the Lord God. They were angry when things did not go their way.

2Ch 24:17 Now after the death of Jehoiada came the princes of Judah, and made obeisance to the king. Then the king hearkened unto them.

2Ch 24:18 And they left the house of the LORD God of their fathers, and served groves and idols: and **wrath came upon Judah and Jerusalem for this their trespass**.

2Ch 24:19 Yet he sent prophets to them, to bring them again unto the LORD; and they testified against them: but they would not give ear.

2Ch 24:20 And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? **because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you.**

As we read the Old Testament, we find that things have not changed over the centuries. They flattered themselves in their sinfulness, their wickedness in the sight of the Lord God. The Lord brought the children of Israel out of Egypt, and, yet, they mocked God as they turned away from Him after their deliverance.

Jeremiah, Chapter 23, reveals to us the Lord's wrath upon His people who chose to walk in their sinful ways. Look around you today, wherever you go and you will see the gods, the idols, of the peoples of the world brought to this nation. You see how the people have invited them in and have joined with them in the worship of their gods, their idols.

As I have written in an earlier *Message*, I have questions when people want to come to this nation because they say they are mistreated – uh, or are they? Why would you move to another nation and take with you all that you have - to continue your way of life in the new country – if, if where you were was so bad?

Read Deuteronomy 29.16-21, especially verses 18 and 19.

(For ye know how we have dwelt in the land of Egypt; and how we came through the nations which ye passed by;

And ye have seen their abominations, and their idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, which *were* among them:)

Lest there should be among you man, or woman, or family, or tribe, whose heart turneth away this day from the LORD our God, to go *[and]* serve the gods of these nations; lest there should be among you a root that beareth gall and wormwood;

And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst:

The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven.

And the LORD shall separate him unto evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law:

Oh, why do we not have any fear of the Lord God Who has given us His all, Who loves us so very much? How can we mock Him like we do, and walk in our own willful way? Why do we spurn Him?

Look around you with the virus that came from the East and spread very quickly to all nations and has caused even here in the U.S. some states to close their "borders" (*used to be state lines*). Countries have closed their borders to other nations. Schools are closed, businesses are closed, and people are dying. Try buying groceries and other supplies necessary for life.

Oh, I understood a number of years ago when the word "border" began to be used instead of state-lines. Many mocked me and said, What is in a word? Who cares! You say state-lines, we modern, updated, educated, people say borders; what is the deal with you not updating to the word borders?

Oh, now I can use borders because there are not state-lines, but borders if you are trying to cross over to another country, uh – I mean state. I understood long ago what was taking place in the U.S. regarding each state . . .

God's wrath was stirred all through history, and I believe is today. The sad part is that His wrath was, and is, stirred by His own people, those who have now turned away from Him to rewrite the Bible, to make it as impotent as possible. Sadly, God's Word

will stand and will stand strong come what may for the Lord God is Almighty and powerful.

Colossians 3.6 makes clear that the wrath of God comes upon the disobedient.

For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:

The children of disobedience are those who perhaps were His followers, but have turned a dear ear to the Lord, and are walking in their own willful way. All through history, those claiming to be a follower of the Lord God seem to have turned a dear ear to the Word of the Lord believing they can say God understands, or they will turn back to the Lord – later. Oh, we know not the day or the hour of the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ, He Who will return for His people who are following Him. When the day of His appearing comes, there will be no time to cross over from the broad road that leads to hell – to the straight and narrow road that leads to heaven.

And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive *[his]* mark in his forehead, or in his hand,

The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.

Here is the patience of the saints: here *[are]* they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed *[are]* the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.

There will be no excuse for anyone who rejects the Lord God Almighty in Christ Jesus. Jesus came, was crucified on the Cross of Calvary, died, was buried, and rose victoriously over sin, hell, and the grave – that you and I might have life for evermore, serving Him now and one day going on to be with Him for evermore. We must repent of our sins, and ask Jesus Christ to come into our lives and choose to live a life of holiness in Him.
