Edifying the Body of Christ (Eph. 4.10-16)

Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Years ago, my colleague and I were talking to someone about our travels coast to coast for the Lord Jesus Christ and how the Lord put before us the body of Christ to edify, those who knew the Lord as their Lord and Savior. They understand that whatever they do for a living, wherever they go each day, and their family life is their opportunity to witness to people about Jesus Christ and endeavor to lead people to Jesus, to speak the Truth of the Lord, to encourage those who know Jesus Christ as Lord, and to ask people, "Do you know my Jesus? Have you heard that He loves you and will abide with you to the end?"

We are commanded to go forth revealing the Truth to people that they might know Jesus Christ, that they might know the wrath of God is upon this nation, and begin a life anew in Him, and be strengthened for these days that lie before us.
