## How is it with your soul?

**S**omething significant that is not understood in the Matthew 18.20 passage are the words, "in my Name." Matthew 28.19, 20 is the Great Commission and has that phrase in it. Those with limited understanding and vocabulary, out of their own desire not to learn, believe that Jesus was saying His Name. Yes, but there is more to that word in the original language; to baptize in His Name is to do so in His authority, in His power.

To "gather in My Name" is to gather in the power and authority of His Name – also. He says that where two or three gather "in My Name," in the power and authority of My Name, "there am I in the midst of them."

There are many *square* buildings packed out with the thousands – but are not meeting "in My Name," in the power and authority of the Lord Jesus Christ. It is not the numbers, but the relationship that the few have with the many - that may not be meeting in the Name of Jesus Christ, the Lord.

### Plumbline: I Peter 2.9

But ye [are] a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

Perhaps there needs to be some soul searching as King David prayed:
