How many times have you felt you were walking through the Valley of the Shadow of Death – and all alone?

We no longer are taught to memorize verses from the Holy Bible. People cannot seemingly quote the scripture, nor do they have any idea where different scriptures are found in the Holy Bible, nor do they know the books of the Bible – nor the need for the Word of God in their lives.

He is writing his own experience with the Lord, and is strong in the Lord, and has experienced many a battle in life, so to speak. He reveals to you where he is with the Lord -when he writes that though he is walking through the valley of the shadow of death, "I will fear no evil: for thou (Lord God) art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me."
