Amo 7:7 Thus he shewed me: and, behold, the Lord stood upon a wall
[made] by a plumbline, with a plumbline in his hand.

How is it with your soul?

We must know the Word, the Living Word, Jesus Christ, as well as the written Word, the Holy Bible, that we might not be led astray. Oh, I have heard those standing on the pulpit taking scripture out of context, and people are so happy in what they are hearing, believing it to be the Gospel of Jesus Christ, not realizing they are being led astray – because they know not the Word. We must spend time reading the Holy Bible with our hearts that we might learn of the Lord Jesus Christ. Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

People often get side-tracked with the Holy Word, finding those things over which to debate using vain words, enticing words, to distract people in joining them.

The Word of God makes it clear that in which we are not to engage, lest we falter. We are to be in the Word and read with our hearts in context. Many of the few that engage in the reading of the Bible take things out of context and distract those like themselves who are unlearned in the Holy Word. It is the blind leading the blind, sad to say – to include those standing on a pulpit.

How sad that people want to talk about ideas they have about faith, standing on a platform that you do not want to go near, lest you fall through the false platform with them.

Why are we not sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ, that He is the only begotten Son of the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, of Israel. People talk about ideas or teachings out of context from the Bible, but care nothing about the Word, the Living word, Jesus Christ.

It is a sad day because people are interested in philosophy, debates, vain words, enticing words, flattering words, disputations . . . The Bible says to "from such withdraw thyself."

He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings,
