Eze 47:1 Afterward he brought me again unto the door of the house; and, behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the house eastward: for the forefront of the house *[stood toward]* the east, and the waters came down from under from the right side of the house, at the south *[side]* of the altar.

Eze 47:2 Then brought he me out of the way of the gate northward, and led me about the way without unto the utter gate by the way that looketh eastward; and, behold, there ran out waters on the right side.

Eze 47:3 And when the man that had the line in his hand went forth eastward, he measured a thousand cubits, and he brought me through the waters; the waters *[were]* to the ankles.

Eze 47:4 Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through the waters; the waters *[were]* to the knees. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through; the waters *[were]* to the loins.

Eze 47:5 Afterward he measured a thousand; *[and it was]* a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.

Eze 47:6 And he said unto me, Son of man, hast thou seen *[this]*? Then he brought me, and caused me to return to the brink of the river.

Eze 47:7 Now when I had returned, behold, at the bank of the river *[were]* very many trees on the one side and on the other.

I have heard it all, it seems. People are crying out for the Word of God, for the Truth of the Lord God Almighty, instead of those standing on the pulpits in the square building where they attend. There is hunger, and few there be that find the manna for which they are seeking – because few there be that have tasted of the manna.

Mat 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *[is]* the gate, and broad *[is]* the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:

Mat 7:14 Because strait *[is]* the gate, and narrow *[is]* the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

Mat 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Come apart and rest (Mark 6.31).

Eze 47:8 Then said he unto me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: *[which being]* brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed.

Eze 47:9 And it shall come to pass, *[that]* every thing that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and every thing shall live whither the river cometh.

Eze 47:10 And it shall come to pass, *[that]* the fishers shall stand upon it from Engedi even unto Eneglaim; they shall be a *[place]* to spread forth nets; their fish shall be according to their kinds, as the fish of the great sea, exceeding many.

Eze 47:11 But the miry places thereof and the marishes thereof shall not be healed; they shall be given to salt.

Eze 47:12 And by the river upon the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit thereof be consumed: it shall bring forth new fruit according to his months, because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary: and the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.

Ezekiel 47 is a powerful chapter as one sits with it and experiences the waters coming forth from deep within in great power. The outpouring of the Holy Spirit from the throne of God in Christ Jesus pours forth into Christ's Holy Church, to strengthen us for the work that lies before us for the Lord Jesus Christ – if we but open our hearts to the hearing of His Word to us.

The grace of the Lord God Almighty that pours forth from the throne of God is for the Church. How sad that most think of their square building, their small group as being THE church. As we experience the waters pouring forth to Christ's Holy Church, let us understand that the Christ's Holy Church are those who have truly repented of their sins, have asked Jesus Christ to come into their hearts, their lives to live, and are endeavoring to live a life of holiness – which is far different than the world and the worldly churches and those standing on pulpits.

The waters that pour forth from the river of life bring healing in our hearts and our lives, and can bring healing in the nations. However, each nation must seek healing from the waters that pour forth from the throne of the Lord God Almighty in Christ Jesus by the Holy Spirit. Each nation which is comprised of the people must search their hearts, and come forward with power from the Lord Jesus Christ in their words and declare there is but one God, - and that God is the Lord God Almighty in Christ Jesus by the Holy Spirit; there is none other. To proclaim this, the nation must do what the children of Israel were told to do when they had invited in those of other countries who worshiped many gods - and brought them with them to the children of Israel.

If you recall, the children of Israel were taken captive by Babylon. The Lord told them they had to serve Babylon for 70 years because of their sin. Some have said to me, "So, we are going to Babylon?" as they laugh in my face. No, we are not. We are in Babylon, and many are already serving their gods, have walked in their own willful way. People have been crossing the chasm under the leadership of Satan, and have no conscience. They related only to plastic and the ways of Satan, who seduced them long ago in this nation – with the help of Satan's followers.

 Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.
 But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.
 But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned *[them]*;
 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Pastors, Shepherds, all followers of the Lord Jesus Christ, step into the River of Life and drink of the Word, the living Word, Jesus Christ, that you shall no longer walk with the world, no longer walk with those "*pastors, shepherds, prophets*" who are standing on the pulpitum and giving forth the words of Satan, encouraging you to walk on with the god of this world.

Note that in the Gospel of Matthew.

 Mar 13:15 And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter *[therein]*, to take any thing out of his house:
 Mar 13:16 And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment.
 Mar 13:17 But woe to them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!
 Mar 13:18 And pray ye that your flight be not in the winter.
 Mar 13:19 For *[in]* those days shall be affliction, such as was not from the beginning of the creation which God created unto this time, neither shall be.
 Mar 13:20 And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days.
 Mar 13:21 And then if any man shall say to you, Lo, here *[is]* Christ; or, lo, *[he is]* there; believe *[him]* not:
 Mar 13:22 For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall shew signs and wonders, to seduce, if *[it were]* possible, even the elect.
