How is it with your soul?

Bahum makes it clear regarding establishing a watch in your life, among your families, and the true family of the Lord God Almighty. There are passages in the Word of the Lord that is most helpful if we but read the Word.

He that dasheth in pieces is come up before thy face: keep the munition, watch the way, make [thy] loins strong, fortify [thy] power mightily (Nah 2.1).

We need to prepare for warfare as when the enemy approaches, as he does daily, we need to be prepared with the Word of God flowing out from us. We need also to be prepared at all times, as we are in prayer that we might know the voice of the Lord as He speaks to us. Many believe any voice they hear, to include their own, is God. Oh, No! The voice of the Lord is one of authority that comes to us to guide us in *The Way* of the Lord for His glory and for our good.

Let us be ever be in the Word of God, the Holy Bible, and prayer - and fight with the weapons given to us in Ephesians Six.
