### Plumblime: Mark 10.21

Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.

### One thing thou lackest!

When I have read this passage in Mark 10, I have said to myself, I wish it were just one thing for me! Well, as I read and re-read this passage, and sit with the Lord, I realize it is true: One thing thou lackest!

We are called to "love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself" (Lk 10.27).

The question then comes, How can I say I "love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself" - if I am not willing to give to the poor? I realize we live in a day and age where people are truly poor, so poor they do not want to work, they have no self respect, and are lazy, want people to wait on them hand and foot, because life is about themselves.

I admit it is hard to know, sometimes, who are they that are poor. Well, come to think of it the people mentioned in the above paragraph are truly poor, poor in spirit. So the question is, How do we reach out and help them?

The answer is by sharing "The Love of God" in Christ Jesus, that they shall repent of their sins, and be filled with the love of the Lord Jesus Christ. But we must first love the Lord, sit in His presence; serve Him, lead others to Jesus Christ, walk in obedience, in His holiness, righteousness.

We need to sit in the presence of the Lord, love Him "with all our heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself"
