Jdg 2:1 And an angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said, I

Jdg 2:15 Whithersoever they went out, the hand of the LORD was against them
for evil, as the LORD had said, and as the LORD had sworn unto them: and
they were greatly distressed.

Jdg 2:16 Nevertheless the LORD raised up judges, which delivered them out of
the hand of those that spoiled them.

Jdg 2:17 And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a
whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned
quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, obeying the
commandments of the LORD; [but] **they did not so.**
