Amo 7:7 Thus he shewed me: and, behold, the Lord stood upon a wall [made] by a plumbline, with a plumbline in his hand.

How is it with your soul?

How long since you read the Word of the Lord and sought His way? How long since you knew the Lord in your life, walking in obedience to Him? How long since you said, "No" to the enemy and his followers, and decided to walk with the Lord Jesus Christ and all for His glory?

The Lord has made it clear that we cannot straddle the fence. This is about living for Jesus in all you do and wherever you go. There is but one way, and it is His way.

Let us be ever mindful of the Word when the Lord tells us to depart from the wicked, though their words are flowery and inviting. Seek the Lord to give you discernment to recognize the wicked of whom the Lord speaks in both the Old Testament and the New Testament.

And he spake unto the congregation, saying, Depart, I pray you, from the tents of these wicked men, and touch nothing of theirs, lest ye be consumed in all their sins.

Perhaps there needs to be some soul searching as King David prayed:

Psa 139:23 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:

Psa 139:24 And see if [there be any] wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

But also take note of Moses walking in obedience to what is much, much later written in the New Testament.

And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead (Lk 16.31).

Oh, the Pharisees of yesteryear and today have not the Spirit of the Lord in them. They speak words, but their hearts do not know *The Love of God* in Christ Jesus. They betray the Lord, walk against Him because they do not know Him. They do not walk in obedience to Him anymore than those in the Book of Numbers.

But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart (II Cor 3.15).

Oh, how people walk with those out of whose mouth flows goodly words. But the Lord God Almighty in Christ Jesus speaks to the people today, and they are listening no better than in the following passage.

And he spake unto the congregation, saying, Depart, I pray you, from the tents of these wicked men, and touch nothing of theirs, lest ye be consumed in all their sins (Num 16.26).

The Lord has made it clear that we are to walk in Him and Him alone. How long since you sought the Lord in your daily walk? Are you walking with the Lord Jesus Christ - or another? Choose you this day whom you will serve (Jos 24.15).
