[made] by a plumblin, with a plumblin in his hand.

## How is it with your soul?

The Lord calls us walk humbly with the Lord. When we walk humbly with Him, our eyes will be upon Him and His thoughts, His ways. We will not see others and what they are doing, but will have our eyes and heart fixed upon the Lord God and what He is doing in us - and all for His glory. We will pray for the whole body with love and humility, desiring to serve the Lord where He has called us, desiring that He shall receive the glory. Mic 6:8 He hath shewed thee, O man, what [is] good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?

Let us walk on the *Via Dolorosa* with arms outstretched to others to come and walk with us, to walk in the Light of the Lord Jesus Christ.

### Plumblin: Isaiah 2.5

# Walking in the Light

Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

I invite you to take time to review the ministry to which the Lord Jesus has called you. Take time to read the Bible to better understand what the Lord Jesus Christ calls each member of His body to do in working together as a member within the context of the Body. This is each one working together as the whole body of Christ.

The Lord Jesus Christ calls us to serve Him, to allow Him to work in us and through us to bring others into His body. Know that entering into the body of Christ is to repent of your sins, ask the Lord to come into your heart and life - to live and to guide us to know His will in our lives daily - and all for His glory.

Serving the Lord Jesus Christ is within the context of endeavoring to become one with Him and one with His body. It is to walk humbly with thy God.

Mic 4:1 But in the last days it shall come to pass, [that] the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and people shall flow unto it.

Mic 4:2 And many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Mic 4:3 And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

Mic 4:4 But they shall sit every man under his vine and under his fig tree; and none shall make [them] afraid: for the mouth of the LORD of hosts hath spoken [it].

Mic 4:5 For all people will walk every one in the name of his god, and we will walk in the name of the LORD our God for ever and ever.

Mic 4:6 In that day, saith the LORD, will I assemble her that halteth, and I will gather her that is driven out, and her that I have afflicted;

Mic 4:7 And I will make her that halted a remnant, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and the LORD shall reign over them in mount Zion from henceforth, even for ever.

Mic 4:8 And thou, O tower of the flock, the strong hold of the daughter of Zion, unto thee shall it come, even the first dominion; the kingdom shall come to the daughter of Jerusalem.

Psa 119:11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.
