Amo 7:7 Thus he shewed me: and, behold, the Lord stood upon a wall [made] by a plumbline, with a plumbline in his hand.

How is it with your soul?

Many may say with Joshua, "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord," as did the children of Israel in verse 16; however, read Joshua 24, then follow on through the Holy Bible how the Israelites did not keep their word. Joshua warned them in verse 20.

If ye forsake the LORD, and serve strange gods, then he will turn and do you hurt, and consume you, after that he hath done you good.

Saying you are following Jesus Christ is not enough. The Lord God Almighty in Jesus Christ calls us to follow Him.

And he said to [them] all, If any [man] will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross **daily**, and **follow me** (Lk 9.23).

Walking with Jesus Christ is a daily walk with our hearts and our lives for His glory.

Psa 139:23 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:

Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods.

And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, [and] be merry.

But God said unto him, [Thou] fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

So [is] he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God (Lk 12.16-21).

Yes, we are called to make a decision in this life. We cannot walk with one foot on the strait and narrow way that leads to heaven and the other one on the broad road that leads to destruction.

Look at the decision that you must make in this life to know the joy of the Lord through all eternity.
