Exo 32:2 And Aaron said unto them, Break off the golden earrings, which *[are]* in the ears of your wives, of your sons, and of your daughters, and bring *[them]* unto me.

Exo 32:3 And all the people brake off the golden earrings which *[were]* in their ears, and brought *[them]* unto Aaron.

Exo 32:4 And he received *[them]* at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These *[be]* thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

Exo 32:5 And when Aaron saw *[it]*, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made proclamation, and said, To morrow *[is]* a feast to the LORD.

Exo 32:6 And they rose up early on the morrow, and offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and to drink, and rose up to play.

Rev 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

Rev 7:10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.

Rev 7:11 And all the angels stood round about the throne, and *[about]* the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God,

Rev 7:12 Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, *[be]* unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.

Rev 7:13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?

Rev 7:14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Rev 7:15 Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.

Rev 7:16 They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.

Rev 7:17 For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.

Where is the true Church of the Lord God Almighty in Christ Jesus?

Where is the body that is fitly joined together for the glory of the Lord, that is edifying the body of Christ (Eph 4.7-16)?

Where is the body that walks in perfect harmony in Christ Jesus for His glory, The Church that is about the work of the Lord Jesus Christ and all for His glory?

Where is the body of Christ whose mind and heart is about the Work of the Lord, that is willing to go forth preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ (Lk 10.1-16)?

Where are the people who come together under the Lordship of Jesus Christ and go out to tell others of His great love (Mt 28.16-20)?

Where are the people who walk together in Christ Jesus, living a life of holiness in Him (1 Th 4.1-8)?

Where are the followers of Jesus Christ Who are walking on the *Via Dolorosa, The Way of the Cross*, "The way, the truth, and the life," in Jesus Christ (Jn 14.6)?

Where are the people who are in the Word of the Lord, studying "to shew themselves approved unto the Lord God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth"? (II Tim 2.15)

Where or where is the body of Christ that has great faith in Jesus Christ and is willing to carry a brother to the Lord who stands in need (Mt 9.2; Mk 2.5; Lk 5.20)?

Where is the true Church of the Lord God Almighty in Christ Jesus, the body of Christ who is walking one with another under the Lordship of Jesus Christ.(I Jn 1.5-10)?

Where is The Church, Christ's Holy Church, who understands that each member of the body of Christ is in ministry and are serving the Lord Jesus Christ as one in the Lord (I Cor 12.12-26)?

For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also *[is]* Christ.

For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether *[we be]* Jews or Gentiles, whether *[we be]* bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

For the body is not one member, but many.

If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

If the whole body *[were]* an eye, where *[were]* the hearing? If the whole *[were]* hearing, where *[were]* the smelling?

But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

And if they were all one member, where *[were]* the body?

But now *[are they]* many members, yet but one body.

And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:

And those *[members]* of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely *[parts]* have more abundant comeliness.

For our comely *[parts]* have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that *[part]* which lacked:

That there should be no schism in the body; but *[that]* the members should have the same care one for another.

And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

Where is the body of Christ that is "not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God unto salvation"?

Rom 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Rom 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Where is the body of Christ that is standing fast, standing firm, on the Word of God - not willing to water down the Word of the Lord?

1Co 16:13 **Watch** ye, **stand fast in the faith**, quit you like men, be strong.

1Co 16:14 Let all your things be done with charity.

1Co 16:15 I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and *[that]* they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,)

1Co 16:16 **That ye submit yourselves unto such, and to every one that helpeth with *[us]*, and laboureth.**

1Co 16:17 I am glad of the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus: for that which was lacking on your part they have supplied.

1Co 16:18 For they have refreshed my spirit and yours: therefore acknowledge ye them that are such.

Where is the body of Christ that has put on the whole armour of God in Christ Jesus?

Eph 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

Eph 6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Eph 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *[places]*.

Eph 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Eph 6:14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

Eph 6:15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

Eph 6:16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

Eph 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

Eph 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Where is the body that once knew what it was to come together for all night prayer meetings to seek the Lord to heal this land and cause those who know the Lord Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior to rise up in their spirits under the Lordship of Jesus Christ that this nation might respond as did the children of Israel to Joshua?

Jos 24:16 And the people answered *[Joshua]* and said, God forbid that we should forsake the LORD, to serve other gods;

Jos 24:17 For the LORD our God, he *[it is]* that brought us up and our fathers out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage, and which did those great signs in our sight, and preserved us in all the way wherein we went, and among all the people through whom we passed:

Jos 24:18 And the LORD drave out from before us all the people, even the Amorites which dwelt in the land: *[therefore]* will we also serve the LORD; for he *[is]* our God.

Hear the Word of the Lord that Joshua spoke to the children of Israel.

Jos 24:20 **If ye forsake the LORD, and serve strange gods, then he will turn and do you hurt, and consume you, after that he hath done you good.**
